Please feel free to also donate any item you can to the Food Bank. The list below is what they are short of at the moment.

- milk (long life) 1l cartons
- fruit juice (long life) 1l cartons
- small jars of coffee
- tinned potatoes/mash
- tinned desserts (fruit/custard/rice pudding)
- instant hot chocolate
- tinned ready meals
- tinned ham/corned beef
- tinned fish
- breakfast cereals
- tinned soup
- tinned macaroni cheese
- packets of savoury rice/noodles
- shampoo
- deodorant (roll on)
- toilet rolls
- shower gel

*Carrier bags (strong ones if possible please as foodbanks are in short supply)*

The foodbank prefer donations which are in tins and packets rather than fresh produce and cannot accept items that are out of date or that have alcohol in.
